


Outdoor and Remote Rural First Aid at Work (ORRFAW) 2 Day (14 Hours) Valid for 3 years

This ORRFAW course is delivered over two days and is designed to help employers meet their obligation under HSE Guidance for First Aid at work.

During the course, students will develop the skills and knowledge needed to deal with a range of emergency first aid situations, including administering CPR, using a defibrillator, dealing with wounds and bleeding, minor injuries, Amputation, Catastrophic Bleeding, Hypothermia, Suspension Trauma, Crush Injury, Trauma Bandaging and much more.
